## Learning from 1897 (Part 1)

The illustrations and scriptures below can be used to initiate and expand Bible learning. The illustrations are taken from some Bible stories published in 1897 by Cassell & Co Ltd, London.









- 1. Adam and Eve. 'Then the rib which the Lord God had taken from man He made into a woman.' Genesis 2:22
- 2. **Noah's ark.** 'Of every living thing of all flesh you shall bring two of every sort into the ark, to keep them alive with you; they shall be male and female.' Genesis 6:19
- 3. Tower of Babel. 'Let us build ourselves a city, and a tower whose top is in the heavens.' Genesis 11:4
- 4. Lot's wife. 'His wife looked back behind him, and she became a pillar of salt.' Genesis 19:26










- 1. Abraham and Isaac. 'The lad and I will go yonder and worship, and we will come back to you.' Genesis 22:5
- 2. **Eliezer and Rebekah.** 'Then she quickly let her pitcher down to her hand, and gave him a drink. And when she had finished giving him a drink, she said, "I will draw water for your camels also, until they have finished drinking." 'Genesis 24:18-19
- 3. **Isaac blesses Jacob.** 'The voice is Jacob's voice, but the hands are the hands of Esau. And he did not recognize him, because his hands were hairy like his brother Esau's hands; so he blessed him.' Genesis 27:22-23
- 4. **Joseph is sold as a slave.** 'Then Midianite traders passed by; so the brothers pulled Joseph up and lifted him out of the pit, and sold him to the Ishmaelites for twenty shekels of silver. And they took Joseph to Egypt.' Genesis 37:28








- 1. **Joseph interprets Pharaoh's dream.** 'Then Joseph said to Pharaoh, "The dreams of Pharaoh are one; God has shown Pharaoh what He is about to do." 'Genesis 41:25
- 2. **Joseph recognizes his brothers.** 'Joseph recognized his brothers, but they did not recognize him. Then Joseph remembered the dreams which he had dreamed about them, and said to them, "You are spies!" 'Genesis 42:8-9
- 3. **Moses in a bulrush ark.** 'She took an ark of bulrushes for him, daubed it with asphalt and pitch, put the child in it and laid it in the reeds by the river's bank.' Exodus 2:3







- 1. **Pharaoh's daughter finds Moses.** 'When she saw the ark among the reeds, she sent her maid to get it. And when she opened it, she saw the child, and behold, the baby wept. So she had compassion on him, and said, "This is one of the Hebrews' children." 'Exodus 2:5-6
- 2. The burning bush. 'The Angel of the Lord appeared to him in a flame of fire from the midst of a bush.' Exodus 3:2
- 3. **The Israelites oppression in Egypt.** 'The Lord said: "I have surely seen the oppression of My people who are in Egypt, and have heard their cry because of their taskmasters, for I know their sorrows." 'Exodus 3:7







- 1. Hail, the seventh plague. 'Moses stretched out his rod toward heaven; and the Lord sent thunder and hail. Exodus 9:23
- 2. **Lamb's blood put on doorposts.** 'They shall take some of the blood and put it on the two doorposts and on the lintel of the houses.' Exodus 12:7
- 3. **The Egyptian firstborn die.** 'It came to pass at midnight that the Lord struck all the firstborn in the land of Egypt, from the firstborn of Pharaoh who sat on his throne to the firstborn of the captive who was in the dungeon.' Exodus 12:29








- 1. **Crossing the Red Sea.** 'Then the Lord said to Moses, "Stretch out your hand over the sea, that the waters may come back upon the Egyptians, on their chariots, and on their horsemen." 'Exodus 14:26
- 2. **Miriam's Song.** 'Miriam the prophetess, the sister of Aaron, took the timbrel in her hand; and all the women went out after her with timbrels and with dances.' Exodus 15:20
- 3. Manna. 'When the children of Israel saw it, they said to one another, "What is it?" ' Exodus 16:15







- 1. **The ark of the covenant.** 'They shall make an ark of acacia wood; two and a half cubits shall be its length, a cubit and a half its width, and a cubit and a half its height. And you shall overlay it with pure gold, inside and out.' Exodus 25:10-11
- 2. **Aaron the High Priest.** 'They shall make holy garments for Aaron your brother and his sons, that he may minister to Me as priest.' Exodus 28:4
- 3. Aaron and the golden calf. 'He fashioned it with an engraving tool, and made a moulded calf.' Exodus 32:4










- 1. **Moses breaks the 10 commandments tablets.** 'As soon as he came near the camp, that he saw the calf and the dancing. So Moses' anger became hot, and he cast the tablets out of his hands and broke them at the foot of the mountain.' Exodus 32:19
- 2. **The Tabernacle.** 'You shall set up the tabernacle of the tent of meeting.' Exodus 40:2
- 3. Quail. 'The people stayed up all that day, all night, and all the next day, and gathered the quail.' Numbers 11:32
- 4. **The bronze serpent.** 'Then the Lord said to Moses, "Make a fiery serpent, and set it on a pole; and it shall be that everyone who is bitten, when he looks at it, shall live." So Moses made a bronze serpent, and put it on a pole; and so it was, if a serpent had bitten anyone, when he looked at the bronze serpent, he lived.' Numbers 21:8-9








- 1. Rahab. Two spies. 'Then she let them down by a rope through the window, for her house was on the city wall.' Joshua 2:15
- 2. Crossing the Jordan river. 'The people crossed over opposite Jericho.' Joshua 3:16
- 3. Jericho. 'You shall march around the city.' Joshua 6:3







- 1. **City of Ai destroyed.** 'When Joshua and all Israel saw that the ambush had taken the city and that the smoke of the city ascended, they turned back and struck down the men of Ai.' Joshua 8:21
- 2. **The large stone under the oak.** 'Then Joshua wrote these words in the Book of the Law of God. And he took a large stone, and set it up there under the oak that was by the sanctuary of the Lord.' Joshua 24:26
- 3. **Shamgar and an ox goad.** Shamgar the son of Anath, who killed six hundred men of the Philistines with an ox goad; and he also delivered Israel. Judges 3:31










- 1. **Gideon and the fleece.** When he rose early the next morning and squeezed the fleece together, he wrung the dew out of the fleece, a bowlful of water. Judges 6:38
- 2. Samson and the lion. 'The Spirit of the Lord came mightily upon him, and he tore the lion apart.' Judges 14:6
- 3. **Boaz and Ruth.** 'Then Boaz said to Ruth, "You will listen, my daughter, will you not? Do not go to glean in another field, nor go from here, but stay close by my young women." 'Ruth 2:8







- 1. Hannah prays. 'Eli answered and said, "Go in peace, and the God of Israel grant your petition." '1 Samuel 1:17
- 2. **Eli and Samuel.** 'The Lord called Samuel. And he answered, "Here I am!" So he ran to Eli and said, "Here I am, for you called me." And he said, "I did not call; lie down again." And he went and lay down.' 1 Samuel 3:4-5
- 3. Dagon: headless and handless. 'The head of Dagon and both the palms of its hands were broken off.' 1 Samuel 5:4









- 1. **Samuel anoints David.** 'Then Samuel took the horn of oil and anointed him in the midst of his brothers; and the Spirit of the Lord came upon David from that day forward.' 1 Samuel 16:13
- 2. David kills Goliath. 'He fell on his face to the earth.' 1 Samuel 17:49
- 3. Saul throws a spear at David. 'Saul sought to pin David to the wall with the spear, but he slipped away.' 1 Samuel 19:10








- 1. Saul kills himself. 'Saul took a sword and fell on it.' 1 Samuel 31:4
- 2. The Ark is brought to Jerusalem. 'David danced before the Lord with all his might.' 2 Samuel 6:14
- 3. **Nathan tells David a parable.** 'So David's anger was greatly aroused against the man, and he said to Nathan, "As the Lord lives, the man who has done this shall surely die! And he shall restore fourfold for the lamb, because he did this thing and because he had no pity." Then Nathan said to David, "You are the man!" ' 2 Samuel 12:5-7







- 1. **Solomon becomes King.** '"Long live King Solomon!" And all the people went up after him; and the people played the flutes and rejoiced.' 1 Kings 1:39-40
- 2. **The Queen of Sheba.** 'Now when the queen of Sheba heard of the fame of Solomon concerning the name of the Lord, she came to test him with hard questions. She came to Jerusalem with a very great retinue.' 1 Kings 10:1-2
- 3. Elijah revives the widow's son. 'Elijah said, "See, your son lives!" '1 Kings 17:23
