




1. Mary and Joseph travel to Bethlehem. Luke 2:1-5




2. Magi arrive in Jerusalem from the East. Matthew 2:1-6








3. Mary and Joseph take Jesus to Egypt. Mathew. 2:13-18




4. The family returns to Nazareth. Matthew 2:19-23







5. Jesus travels south to Bethany beyond the Jordan where He is baptised by John. Mark 1:10-11




7. Jesus returns north to Galilee where He performs His first miracle at a family wedding in Cana. John 2:1-12

6. The Holy Spirit leads Jesus into the Judaean Desert where He is tempted by the accuser. Mark 1:12-13




8. Jesus reads from the scroll of the prophet Isaiah in the synagogue at Nazareth. Luke 4:14-30


















9. Jesus journeys to Capernaum where He drives out an evil spirit from a man in the synagogue. Luke 4:31-37




10. Jesus goes up to Jerusalem for the Passover and purges the temple. John 2:13-25



11. Jesus's disciples baptise followers in the river Jordan. John 3:22-36




12. Jesus talks to a Samaritan woman at Jacob's well near Sychar. John 4:1-42

14. Jesus raises a widow's only son from the dead at Nain's city gate. Luke 7:11-17




15. Jesus calls four local fishermen to follow Him at the Sea of Galilee. Mark 1:16-20











16. Jesus calms a storm as He crosses the Sea of Galilee to Gerasa. Mark 4:35-41



17. Jesus returns to Capernaum where He raises Jairus's daughter from the dead. Mark 5:21-43




18. Jesus walks to Nazareth where He is rejected in the synagogue. Mark 6:1-6












19. Jesus crosses the Sea of Galilee to escape the crowds, but they run ahead of him. Mark 6:30-44



20. Jesus walks on the water close to the disciples' boat at night time. Mark 6:45-52




21. Driven off course by a storm, they land at Gennesaret where Jesus heals many people. Mark 6:53-56




22. Jesus travels to Tyre where He casts an evil spirit out of a girl. Mark 7:24-30






