# BIBLE STRUCTURES

**Evidence of Divine Inspiration**

‘The prophets did not think these things up on their own,  
but they were guided by the Spirit of God’ 2 Peter 1:21, CEV.

Bible structures constitute a remarkable phenomenon peculiar to divine revelation and are not found outside the Bible to the same degree in any other form of known literature. They show astonishing symmetry throughout God’s Word. They are easily discerned. Bible structures are not the result of human ingenuity. They can be seen to be one of the most important and convincing evidences of divine inspiration of the sacred text.

The distinguishing feature of Bible structures is the repetition of subjects which reappear either in alternation or introversion or a combination of both. (Alternation and introversion are illustrated below.) Subjects can also be divided. Repetition of subjects is sometimes called ‘correspondence’ as one subject mentioned in one part of the Bible corresponds to another subject found later in the Bible. The repetition may be the same, similar, opposite, or in many other contrasts as well. In this lesson examples of subjects which are in correspondence with each other are connected by black dots with the same random letter. They are always vertically in line with each other.

As can be seen below, symmetrical Bible structures start at the very beginning of the Bible and are in every Bible book. Some are elementary and others are very complex. In total there are over 2,800 Bible structures! This lesson illustrates 98 of them as examples, many have been simplified.
