52 Overview Lessons

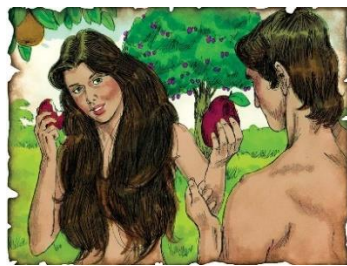
Genesis to Revelation

'These things happened to them as examples and were written for our instruction' ^{1 Corinthians 10:11, NET.}

'The Scriptures were written to teach and encourage us by giving us hope' ^{Romans 15:4, CEV.}



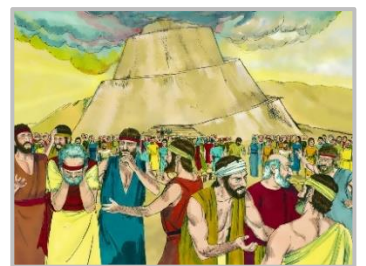
'In the beginning God created the heavens and the earth. The earth was without form, and void; and darkness was on the face of the deep. And the Spirit of God was hovering over the face of the waters' Gen. 1:1-2, *NKJV*. Genesis is the seed-plot of the whole Bible. It is the foundation on which divine revelation rests and on which it is built up. Genesis is quoted 60 times in the New Testament.



In the garden of Eden God said to the serpent: 'I will put enmity between you and the woman, and between your seed and her Seed; He shall bruise your head, and you shall bruise His heel' Gen. 3:15, *NKJV*. This is the first great promise and prophecy. Because Adam and Eve sinned, God expelled them from the garden, so that only through Christ could they have access to the tree of life.



'So Noah went out, and his sons and his wife and his sons' wives with him. Every animal, every creeping thing, every bird, and whatever creeps on the earth, according to their families, went out of the ark' Gen. 8:18-19, *NKJV*. The story of Noah and the Ark is a reminder of Christ, who preserves us. The ark was covered with 'pitch' (Hebrew *kopher*) meaning 'atonement'.

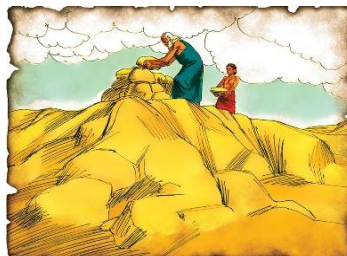


'The LORD said, "Indeed the people are one and they all have one language, and this is what they begin to do; now nothing that they propose to do will be withheld from them. Come, let Us go down and there confuse their language, that they may not understand one another's speech." So the LORD scattered them abroad from there over the face of all the earth' Gen. 11:6-8, *NKJV*.

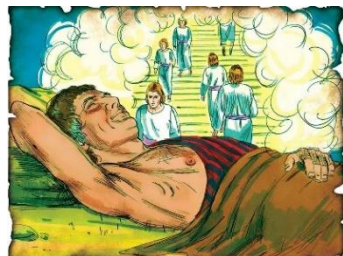


The number of stars are compared to Abraham's descendants! Abraham (a type of God the Father) was willing to give up his only son. In Abraham 'all the families of the earth shall be blessed' (through Christ).

Gen. 12:3, *NKJV*, Gal. 3:16, Gen. 22:17.



'Take now your son, your only son Isaac, whom you love, and go to the land of Moriah and offer him there as a burnt offering' Gen. 22:2, *NKJV*. In Isaac we have a type of Christ who gave himself so as to take away our sins.



In a dream of a ladder set on earth and its top reaching up to heaven, God promises to Jacob that 'in you and in your seed all the families of the earth shall be blessed'. The 'all' can only be fulfilled by Jesus Christ Gen. 28:14, *NKJV*.



Joseph prepared Egypt to survive a famine. He was known for his personal integrity. The faith of Joseph was shown in his confidence that God would fulfil the promises to Abraham, Isaac and Jacob Gen. 50:24, Heb. 11:22.



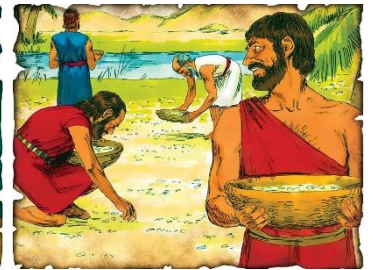
'The Angel of the LORD appeared to him in a flame of fire from the midst of a bush. So he looked, and behold, the bush was burning with fire, but the bush was not consumed.' God speaks to Moses out of a burning bush telling him to go to Egypt to rescue the Israelite slaves and to lead them to a good and large 'land flowing with milk and honey' Ex. 3:2, 8, NKJV.



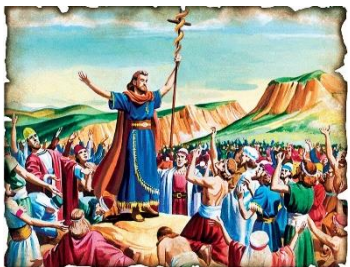
One after another, nine devastating plagues strike Pharaoh and the land of Egypt. Then during the tenth plague the LORD passes over Egypt and all the firstborn die. However, in Israel 'when He sees the blood on the lintel and on the two doorposts, the LORD will pass over the door and not allow the destroyer to come into your houses' Ex. 12:23, NKJV.



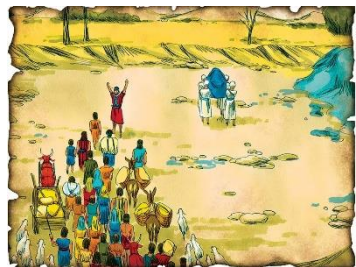
'Moses said to the people, "Do not be afraid. Stand still, and see the salvation of the LORD, which He will accomplish." . . . 'The LORD said to Moses . . . "Tell the children of Israel to go forward. But lift up your rod, and stretch out your hand over the sea and divide it. And the children of Israel shall go on dry ground through the midst of the sea"' Ex. 14:13, 15-16, NKJV.



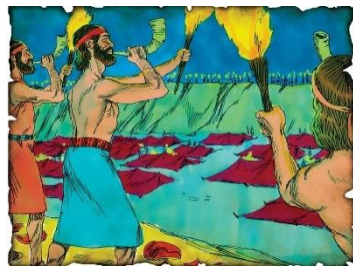
'On the surface of the wilderness, was a small round substance, as fine as frost on the ground. So when the children of Israel saw it, they said to one another, "What is it?" For they did not know' Ex. 16:14-15, NKJV. In John 6:49 Jesus refers to manna. Jesus says 'I am the living bread that came down from heaven. If anyone eats of this bread, he will live forever' John 6:51, NKJV.



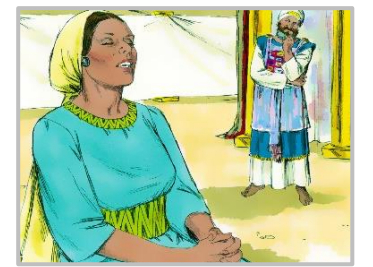

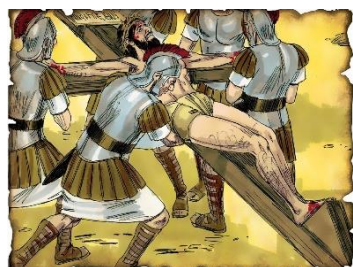


Samuel took a horn of oil and anointed David King 'and the Spirit of the LORD came upon David' 1 Sam. 16:13, NKJV.

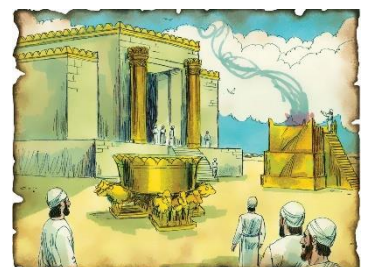
The Davidic Covenant

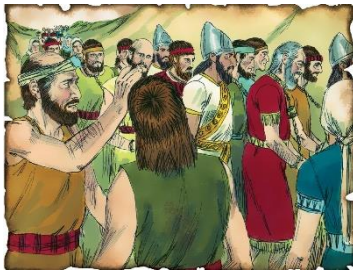

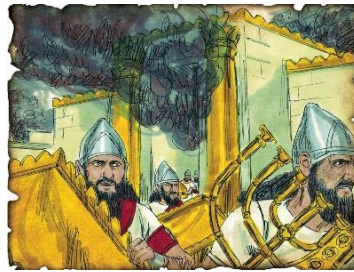

'In the future, everyone will worship and learn about you, our Lord. People not yet born will be told, "The Lord has saved us!"' Ps. 22:1, 16, 18, NKJV. 30-31, CEV. David wrote Psalm 22.



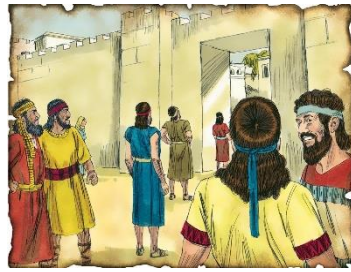
'David said, "Solomon my son is young and inexperienced, and the house to be built for the LORD must be exceedingly magnificent, famous and glorious"' 1 Chron. 22:5, NKJV. Following is one of Solomon's many proverbs: 'Pleasant words are like a honeycomb, sweetness to the soul and health to the bones' Prov. 16:24, NKJV.



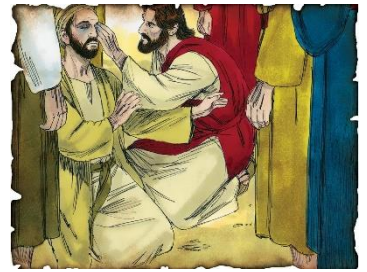
'In the ninth year of Hoshea, the king of Assyria captured Samaria and deported the Israelites to Assyria' 2 Kings 17:6, *NIV*. Despite many warnings from God's prophets, the nation of Israel continued to sin, so God allows the Assyrians to take the northern 10 tribes into captivity.



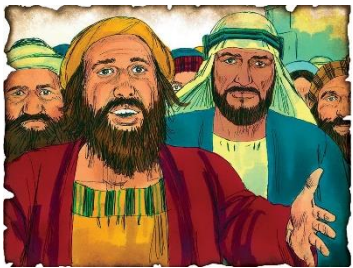
'All the articles from the house of God, great and small, the treasures of the house of the LORD, and the treasures of the king and of his leaders, all these he took to Babylon. Then they burned the house of God' 2 Chron. 36:18-19, *NKJV*. For disobedience, Judah is taken into Babylonian captivity.



'They came to Jerusalem to celebrate the dedication of the wall of Jerusalem. They came to sing songs of praise and thanks to God' Neh. 12:27, *ERV*. After 70 years of captivity in Babylon the Israelites returned to Jerusalem with their leaders Nehemiah, Ezra and Zerubbabel.



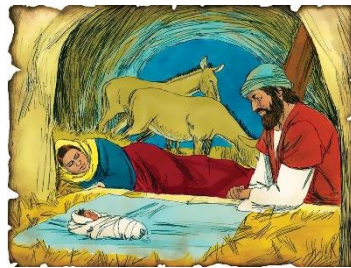
The Messiah in Isaiah.

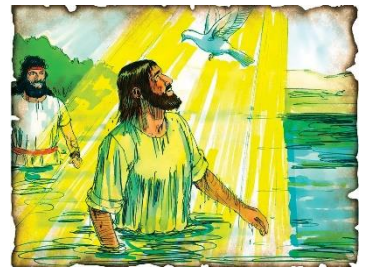

Nebuchadnezzar's dream of a great image is interpreted by Daniel who tells him that the Messiah, the Rock, will destroy all worldly empires and will finally rule in His everlasting kingdom of righteousness with the saints. Based on the GCI article: *The Prophetic Meaning of Daniel 2*.



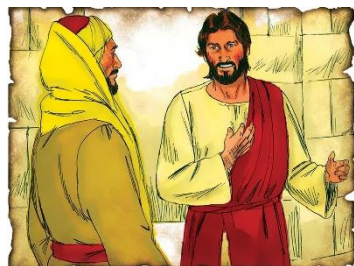
